

## EMERGENCY SUPPLY CHECKLIST

It is very important that you **PREPARE** your family with a disaster plan and have a few supplies on hand in your shelter area. FEMA recommends **THREE** days' worth of supplies to include the following:

<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>WATER</b> 1 Gallon Per Person Per Day
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>FOOD</b> Non-Perishable foods, Pet Food, Infant Formula, Specialty Foods (if required) ***Don't forget your MANUAL Can Opener!!!
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>LIGHTING</b> Flash Lights, Emergency battery or solar operated lights, crank lanterns, LED lighting, Light Sticks ***Nothing Requiring Flame/Fire***
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>COMFORTS</b> Wool Blankets, Solar Blankets, Body Warmers, Rain Coat, Sleeping Bag, Extra Clothing, Socks, Hard Soled Shoes/Boots
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>TOOLS</b> Fire Extinguisher, Wrench or Pliers to Turn off Utilities, Gloves, Shovel, Etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>MEDICAL KIT</b> Include prescription drugs, glasses, contact solution, survival/medical guide, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>SANITATION/HYGIENE</b> Moist towelettes, bucket, garbage bags, plastic ties, diapers, feminine supplies, mouth wash, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>EMERGENCY SIGNALING &amp; COMMUNICATION</b> Whistles, Distress Banner, Crank/Battery Operated Radio and Cell Charger, Electric Battery Operated Flare, Extra Batteries
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>DOCUMENTATION</b> Store cash, copies of insurance policies, birth certificates, deeds, identification, Wills, marriage license, updated address book, household inventory, disposable camera, emergency contacts.  ***Keep in fire resistant documentation bag within a waterproof container***
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>MISCELLANEOUS</b> Mess kit, paper and pencil, books, games, personal protection, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>FAMILY DISASTER PLAN</b> Develop an emergency plan and practice with your family on a regular basis
